In mid-May, you will receive a personalized newsletter, this time to the email address you entered in your application to studera.nu. In this letter, there will be instructions on how to log on to the course platform in order to start the course. It is very important that you read the information carefully. In addition you will also get a computer account, sent to the home address you provided in your application to studera.nu. Would any of these addresses no longer be relevant, it is very important that you directly send an email to [distans@dsv.su.se](mailto:distans@dsv.su.se) and tell us the new email or/and home address, otherwise you might not get the information you require to start the course.

You will be able to apply for a Certificate of CSN or A-kassan(unemployment fund) through the course platform. Certificate to CSN will be sent directly to CSN in Strömsund. Certificate to A-kassan will be sent to your home address.
